RE: INCLEMENT WEATHER WARNING – PORT OF DURBAN AND SURROUNDS

Please note that strong winds are predicted gusting over 45 knots SW later on this afternoon. The office of the Harbour Master at the Port of Durban has taken a decision to evacuate some of the vessels which have a higher risk of exposure.

Updated list of berths to be evacuated:


- Berth 203 and 204 already evacuated.
- Berth 108 and 107 still to be evacuated resources already dispatched.
- Berth 105 vessel request to be left alongside the quay and will deploy additional mooring lines.

In the interest of safety, we request and urge all Port users to take the required precautionary measures, halt vessel operations where required and secure their relevant equipment.

The Port of Durban will monitor the situation as it develops and keep you updated.
